
Why a Carbon Monoxide Alarm is So Important.






Measuring Your Safety

The Bryant Carbon Monoxide Alarm records CO levels in its peak level memory so that health care professionals can quickly assess exposure levels following an alarm. It plugs into any standard electrical outlet for power, but an included rechargeable lithium ion battery ensures continued detection and warning even during a power outage. For peace of mind, you can check to see if your Carbon Monoxide Alarm is functioning properly with the simple push of a button. Bryant recommends weekly testing as well as professional inspections on an annual basis.

Bryant CO Alarm Response Times


This CO alarm meets response time requirements as follows:

- At 70 ppm, unit must alarm within 60-240 min.
- At 150 ppm, unit must alarm within 10-50 min.
- At 400 ppm, unit must alarm within 4-15 min.
